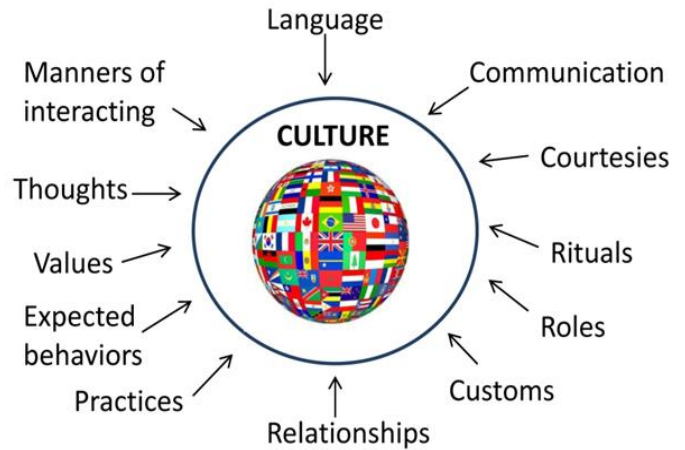


# Beginning Fundamentals

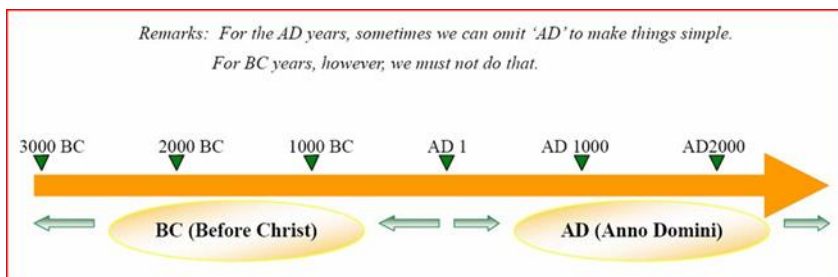

## Time Management:

- ✓ Decade: a period of 10 years
- ✓ Century: a period of 100 years (i.e. 15<sup>th</sup> century = 1400s)
- ✓ Millennium: 1,000 years (3<sup>rd</sup> Millennium was Jan 1, 2001)
- ✓ B.C.: the time Before Christ on a timeline
- ✓ B.C.E.: Before Common Era (replaces B.C.)
- ✓ A.D.: Anno Domini, In the Year of our Lord
- ✓ C.E. Common Era (replaces A.D.)
