











#### Mini Lecture

- Geography is the study of physical features of earth & its atmosphere, human activity as it affects & is affected by it, & use of natural resources.
- The study of geography helps us understand its impacts on human development. Human activity greatly impacts the natural world we live in.
- Geographic Context: where a historical event took place and why it took place there; includes location, location relative to other places, geographic features, and climate
- WHERE YOU LIVE WILL DETERMINE HOW YOU LIVE!
- **Political** maps show boundaries (lines) & locations of political units
- **Physical** maps show location, topography (shape) of earth's land features & physical features
- **Thematic** maps show information relating to specific theme
- Five Themes of Geography are tools to analyze geographic information
  - 1. **Location** shows "Where is it?"
  - 2. Place shows "What is like?"
  - 3. **Region** is an area that shares common features
  - 4. **Movement** shows How & why do people, goods, & ideas move from place to place & results
  - 5. Human-Environment
    Interaction shows How
    people adapt to & change the
    environment
