	Research: *Must list at least 3 separate and relevant sources	
	Presentation/Organization: *Presentation is portrayed in a clear, organized, and logical manner making it interesting and easy to follow *Minimal text on slides is used	
	Creativity: *Presentation must be a unique, original, interesting, and entertaining version of the subject matter *Presentation is engaging, stimulating, and captures the interest of the audience *Presentation must allow for <u>an element of inter-activity between you and the class</u> (i.e. questions, discussion, debate) *Presentation includes excellent use of graphics to supplement & explain text (maps, graphs, charts, quotes, pictures, political cartoons)	
	Content: *Presentation covers topic in a clear, appropriate, and accurate manner *Must provide an interpretation/explanation of the content (not a simple recitation of facts)	
	Delivery: *Student is <u>not simply reading</u> , but is presenting and explaining *Student is eloquent and shows enthusiasm for the subject *Use of appropriate volume and rate of speech. Pronounces words clearly and can easily be heard *Student maintains eye contact with audience and has good usage of body language/posture	
	Timing: Presentation falls within time limit (minimum of 5 minutes and maximum of 7 minutes)	
	Audience: *Write down 3 things you've learned about each presentation *Student is attentive and respectful of other presenters	
F-85 points	85-95 points	95-100 points

Note: if a student receives an excessive number of comments in the left category, your score would fall lower in the F-85 point range. If you met the targeted criteria, your score would fall somewhere between 85 and 95 points. And if you achieved most of the targeted areas but also exceeded them in some ways, your score would fall between 95 and 100 points.
